

## Policy Statement

This document sets out the Safety Policy of Garryowen FC (hereinafter referred to as "the club") and specifies the means provided to achieve that policy and thus comply with the Safety, Health & Welfare at Work Act 2005 and any other relative legislation, to ensure so far as reasonably practicable the safety, health & welfare of all its employees whilst at work and to provide such information, training and supervision as necessary.

The club has as a constant objective, the creation and maintenance of a safe working environment which will not pose undue risk to the safety and health to employees, visitors or members engaged in work at or using the premises as a recreation centre. As an amateur sports club, cognisance is taken of our visitors and members of the public who use our services. We also take cognisance of the different duties carried out by our staff and contractors.

It is the policy of the club to ensure that adequate consultation takes place between management and employees on all aspects of health and safety. Employees are made aware of their legal responsibilities under the Safety, Health & Welfare at Work 2005.
